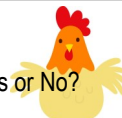
September 15: Main Street Medley's 20th Anniversary. Customer Appreciation Day. At the Alliance Community Hall 7pm to 11pm

The Village of Alliance Bylaw #2019-05 States:

Section 5.A.ii.:

"NUISANCE ANIMALS: No animal shall be allowed to be a nuisance. **A nuisance shall include, but not be limited to:** Biting, scratching or chasing a person or animal; Barking, howling, meowing, chirping or otherwise disturbing any person; Causing damage to property or other animals; Defecating on property on other than that of the owner."

It is the dog owner's responsibility that all dogs behave accordingly. Any and all complaints due to neglect of this bylaw will result in a written warning to the owner and can be accompanied by disciplinary action of a fine.

To report an incident with a dog, come to the Village Office to fill out a Complaint Form. All complaints will remain confidential.
