## ALLIANCE LAND USE BYLAW

## INTERPRETATION:

CORNER LOT means a lot at an intersection of two or more roads or highways, or a road and a highway;
FENCE means a vertical physical barrier constructed for visual screening, sound abatement or security;

## SECTION 3.2 DEVELOPMENT NOT REQUIRING A DEVELOPMENT PERMIT

4) The erection or construction of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure (other than on corner lots or where abutting on a road used by vehicular traffic) less than $1.0 \mathrm{~m}(3.28 \mathrm{ft}$.) in height in front yards and less than 2.0 ( 6.6 ft .) in side and rear yards, and the maintenance, improvement and other alterations of any gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure.

## SECTION 6.9 FENCES, HEDGES AND WALLS

1) Notwithstanding any other regulation respecting required yards in this Bylaw, a fence, hedge or wall may be constructed along a boundary line of a lot or immediately adjacent to a main building.
2) No fence, wall, hedge or other enclosure shall be higher than:
a) $1.82 \mathrm{~m}(6.0 \mathrm{ft}$.) measured as the average elevation from the ground, except
b) $0.91 \mathrm{~m}(3.0 \mathrm{ft}$.$) within a required front yard.$
