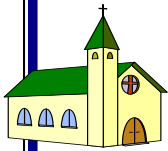

VILLAGE OF ALLIANCE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

BYLAW NO. 2014-03 To amend LAND USE BYLAW 2010-03

TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 2000, as amended, the Council of the Village of Alliance proposes to amend Land Use Bylaw 2010-03 for the Village.

THE PURPOSE of this amendment is to clarify the definition of side yard as follows:

Section 1.5, (144) shall be amended as follows:

(144) **YARD, FRONT** means a yard extending across the full width of a lot from the front line to the nearest wall of the main building situated on the lot. In the case of a curved front line, the front yard will also form a curve;

Section 7.1 **R1-RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT (3) (f) (ii)** shall be amended as follows:

(ii) No fence or wall shall be:

Higher than 1.82 m (6.0 ft.) from surrounding grade in side and rear yards as defined in Section 1.5, (146) and Section 1.5, (145) of this bylaw

Higher than 0.91 m (3.0 ft.) in required front yards as defined in Section 1.5,(144) of this bylaw

Section 7.2 **R2 – RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT (3) (f)** shall be amended as follows:

(f) No fence or wall shall be:

Higher than 1.82 m (6.0 ft.) from surrounding grade in side and rear yards as defined in Section 1.5, (146) and Section 1.5, (145) of this bylaw

Higher than 0.91 m (3.0 ft.) in required front yards as defined in Section 1.5,(144) of this bylaw

Section 7.3 **C1 – CENTRAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT (3) (d) (iii)** shall be amended as follows:

(iii) No fence or wall shall be:

Higher that 2.0 m (6.6 ft.) from surrounding grade in side and rear yards as defined in Section 1.5, (146) and Section 1.5, (145) of this bylaw

Higher than 1.0 m (3.3 ft.) in required front yards as defined in Section 1.5,(144) of this bylaw

Copies of this proposed Bylaw may be reviewed and inspected and/or purchased for a nominal fee by the public at the Village Office in Alliance during the hours of 9 am a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Thursday, of 9 am to Noon on Friday.

At 9 o'clock a.m. on Wednesday, September 10, 2014, the Council of the Village of Alliance will cause a Public Hearing to be held in the Council Chambers at the Village of Alliance Office at 209 Main Street in Alliance, Alberta, at which time objections or comments regarding the proposed Plan and Bylaw may be given and received.

Written submissions may be provided to Council during the Public Hearing, however, it is requested that a copy of the written submission be delivered to the Village Office, attention the Village Administrator, by 3:00 p.m. on Monday, September 8, 2014, in order to ensure that each member of Council has a copy of the written submission for the Public Hearing.
