for any appliance containing freon.

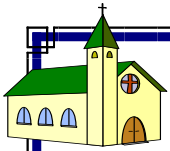

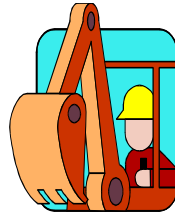
