

Happy October Alliance! We wanted to take this opportunity to clearly communicate the Village Councils responsibilities. Many have been asking us questions about groups and Societies that we, the Village Council, have no say in the way they are being governed.

Council's primary role is to ensure that services are provided to citizens and property owners. Council is responsible for ensuring that the municipality acts within its enabling legislation. As well, council is responsible for ensuring that the municipality meets all requirements established in legislation, develop a budget and levy taxes, appoint an auditor, etc.

The only organisation that a council member has been appointed to sit on are the Village Boards;

The Arena Board: Deputy Mayor, Denise Nychyporuk, The Library Board: Deputy Mayor, Denise Nychyporuk, The Recreation Board: Councillor, Steeve Wyse

All other Alliance Community groups are created when a number of people get together for a common purpose of interest. They are usually started by an individual or group of people that feel the community is in need of the common interest.
