Starting September 24th, there will be a change in the hours of operation for the Fall & Winter seasons.
Every Tuesday we will be open from 12pm to 6pm & Thursday 10am to 4pm

Do not be alarmed,

On November 20th at 1:55pm, there is going to be an Alberta Emergency Alert test (Text Message)

Twice per year, in November and May, a provincewide test alert is issued. These alerts test the system to make sure it works the way it should.

Alberta Emergency Alerts are issued to provide you with critical information about a potentially life-threatening situation in your area, including wildfires, floods, and tornadoes.

Emergency alerts include information about the location of an emergency and what action you need to take to protect yourself. Alerts are sent out on TV, radio, websites, social media, the Alberta Emergency Alert mobile app and compatible smart phones.
