Top news of the month

Alberta is currently in a significant drought. During summer 2023, several water basins reached critical drought conditions due to low rainfall and high temperatures. The world is also experiencing El Niño, a global phenomenon occurring for the first time in seven years. It's causing less snow and rain, along with higher temperatures, heightening the potential for significant drought into spring and summer 2024, particularly in southern Alberta.

The Village of Alliance will not be taking this situation lightly. In the next couple of months we will be using our local newsletter to share tricks and tips for water management in your own home.

Here's a few tricks to keep in mind for this spring:

Take shorter (5 minutes) showers.

Fix leaks, including leaky toilets and faucets. Fill the sink instead of letting the

water run when washing dishes. Keep a jug of cool water in the fridge instead of running the tap.

Use dishwashers and washing machines with full loads only.
