VILLAGE OF ALLIANCE BYLAW #2024-06 MUNICIPAL BOULEVARD BYLAW

Section 2. General Maintenance

- 2.1 A person shall maintain any boulevard or back alley adjacent to the property the owner occupies by:
- i. Keeping any grass on the boulevard cut to a length of no more than 10 centimeters;
- ii. Preventing weeds or other vegetation from growing uncontrolled;

Section 5. Violations and

Penalties: Any person who commits a breach of any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to a penalty of one hundred (\$100) for a first offence and two hundred (\$200) for subsequent



offences within a period of one (1) year.
