Councillors

Serving on Council is a unique opportunity to help shape the future of our community. Councillors work together as a team to set policy and direction for the municipality, always guided by the best interests of the whole community.

Much of this work includes reviewing policies, developing programs, and preparing the annual business plan and budget.

Councils authority is exercised through bylaws and resolutions, in accordance with the **Municipal Government Act (MGA)**. The MGA is one of Alberta's most important statutes, shaping how all municipalities operate across the province.

Who Can Vote in a Municipal Election?

To vote in a municipal election in Alberta, you must:

- Be at least **18 years old** on Election Day
- Be a Canadian citizen
- Be a resident of Alberta
- Reside in the municipality (and ward, if applicable) on Election Day

Voters must also bring **acceptable identification** that shows both their name and current residential address (for example, a driver's licence, Alberta ID card, or another approved form of ID).

If you meet the requirements and have the proper ID, you can vote at your local voting station on Election Day.
